1.4 More detailed information on technical accessibility

The online service is not yet fully accessible.

1.4.1 Content or features that are not yet accessible

- There are images and graphics without appropriate text alternatives. (WCAG 1.1.1)
- There is no captioning or audio description in the videos. (WCAG 1.2.2, 1.2.5)
- Certain colour combinations do not meet the minimum colour contrast requirements. (WCAG 1.4.3, 1.4.11)
- Reflow on the page "Hospital's Virtual Art Gallery" is not fully accessible. (WCAG 1.4.10)
- Certain texts are not fully legible when text spacing is increased. (WCAG 1.4.12)
- The submenus which appear on mouse hover cannot be dismissed without moving the pointer. (WCAG 1.4.13)
- There is no keyboard access. (WCAG 2.1.1)
- The user is unable to pause, stop or hide the moving background image on the start page. (WCAG 2.2.2)
- The focus order is not logical in places, and the focus position is not always appropriate when a new view becomes visible. (WCAG 2.4.3)
- Path-based gestures are required to operate the online service. (WCAG 2.5.1)
- The language of the online service and the language of specific terms is not marked appropriately. (WCAG 3.1.1, 3.1.2)
- Certain elements are not programmatically determinable. (WCAG 1.3.1, 4.1.2)

1.5 How have we tested accessibility?

The observations in this accessibility statement are based on a third-party assessment of whether the online service meets legal requirements.
